CAMP COSTS

Registration costs include: bed, meals, activities, Kid's Camp shirt, a \$5 money card for week 2 and Girls Only a \$10 money card for weeks 1,3,&4 a \$15 money card for week 5 that can be used for concessions and purchases.

- Girls Only: \$110 (\$70 deposit, \$40 at camp)

The deposit is *non-refundable* and *cannot* be transferred to another campers balance.

Late Fees

All applications postmarked after **May 13** for Camps 1-4 or **July 8** for Camp 5 and Girls Only Camp will be subject to a **\$25** late fee.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Deposits must accompany the application for each child and worker registering for camp to hold the spot. Groups should collect the money, and mail

one check. Payments can be made by credit card or check, and may be made payable to: NTDC Kids Camp.

STRICT AGE LIMITS ENFORCED

Camper age limits are set to best assure the safety and welfare of your campers and to promote maximum participation, enjoyment, and benefit for them and the whole camp ministry. DO NOT ASK FOR EXCEPTIONS.

Camp 2 Ages 5-7

(Must be 5 before Sept. 30, 2010, and not older than age 7)

Camps 1, 3-5 Ages 8-12

(Must be 8 before Sept. 30, 2010, and not older than age 12*)

*Campers 12 and older may register with the District Youth Division for Youth Camp.

DORM MONITOR REQUIREMENTS

Due to the amount of time needed to process worker applications, please submit these before the deadline.

Camps 1, 3-5: For each gender, your church **MUST** send at least *1 worker for every 6 children*. For example, if you are bringing 7 girls and 2 boys, your church is **REQUIRED** to bring 2 female workers, and 1 male worker. If you choose to bring more than the required number of workers, you will pay the Additional Monitor rate for those workers. A limited number of Monitors-In-Training (MITs), ages 16 or 17, may be assigned. MITs cannot be responsible for the immediate care and supervision of campers and will be assigned to work with adult monitors.

Camp 2: For each gender, your church **MUST** send at least 1 worker for every 5 children. For example, if you are bringing 6 girls and 2 boys, your church is **REQUIRED** to bring 2 female workers, and 1 male worker. If you choose to bring more than the required number of workers, you will pay the Additional Monitor rate for those workers. A limited number of Monitors-In-Training (MITs), ages 16 or 17, may be assigned. MITs cannot be responsible for the immediate care and supervision of campers and will be assigned to work with adult monitors.

STATE MANDATED BACKGROUND CHECKS

To help safeguard your children and to comply with the State of Texas Administrative Code for Camp Health and Safety, every adult worker must consent to a criminal background search/sex offender registration database check. We strongly recommend that each church conduct their own background checks on their workers. Each adult worker should mark the appropriate box on the application. NTDC will conduct the background checks for a \$5 fee. Screening must be current within 24 months (since 6/2008 for Camps 1-4, or 8/2008 for Camp 5 and Girls Only Camp).

APPLICATIONS AND MEDICAL RELEASES

The properly completed and signed application includes a release for emergency medical treatment and other vital information. No camper or worker can be registered for camp without submitting this application/release. TEXAS STATE POLICY ALSO REQUIRES A MEDICATION FORM TO BE FILLED OUT 24 HOURS PRIOR TO CAMP for those taking medication. **YOU MUST BRING THIS COMPLETED AND SIGNED FORM TO CAMP.**

Please make sure to fill in the correct shirt size on the application; shirts cannot be exchanged for different sizes at camp.

GROUP REGISTRATION

Please designate which children should be together. Every effort will be made to allow for groups to stay in the same cabins or rooms, within the limits of camp structure and the number of beds in each room.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS

Recreation during Kids Camp is often messy! Older, casual play clothes and shoes are needed. Clothes and shoes will get wet, muddy, and generally messy! Please do not send expensive clothing. For evening services, boys may wear slacks, clean jeans, or nice shorts and a shirt. (Suits are not necessary). Girls may wear dresses, slacks, jeans, capris, or shorts that come at least to the mid-thigh

No abbreviated attire (half shirts, tank tops, spaghetti straps, etc.) may be worn at camp. Shoes must be worn at all times, including to and from the pool, as regulated by the state insurance board. Cover clothing must be worn to and from the pool and lake.

WHAT TO BRING

- Clothes (see dress requirements, above)
- Bible, Notepad, & Pen
- Pool Shoes
- Linens or a sleeping bag and pillow
- Towels & Washcloths
- Soap, Shampoo, Toothpaste, Toothbrush
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent

-Campers may bring cash to spend for snacks or concessions, but they will be responsible for their own money.

Please mark clothes and other items with your name and be careful not to lose or misplace them. Campers and workers are responsible for all their own things. **DO NOT BRING CD PLAYERS, HEADSETS, ELECTRONIC GAMES, EXPENSIVE CAMERAS, CELL PHONES, ETC.**

LICE

Make sure each child is checked for lice before boarding your church van for camp.

DEADLINES

Reservation Requests* (if your church chooses to turn one in) must be postmarked by **April 15 for Camps 1-4 or **June 10** for Camp 5 and Girls Only Camp

*If you turned in a *Reservation Request*, all required paperwork must be postmarked by **May 3** for Camps 1-4 or **June 21** for Camp 5 and Girls Only Camp or those reserved spaces will be forfeited.

*The regular deadline for all paperwork is **May 13** for Camps 1-4 or **July 8** for Camp 5 and Girls Only; however, please note that spaces fill on a first come-first served basis.

ALL CAMPS BEGIN AT 3:00 PM AND WILL END AT 11:00 AM (ROOMS AND ACTIVITIES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE UNTIL AFTER 3:00)
